History of Pakistan

Pakistan was one of the two original successor states to British India, which was partitioned along religious lines in 1947. For almost 25 years following independence, it consisted of two separate regions, East and West Pakistan, but now it is made up only of the western sector.

Both India and Pakistan have laid claim to the Kashmir region; this territorial dispute led to war in 1949, 1965, 1971, 1999, and remains unresolved today

History of Pakistan

In 1940, the annual session of Muslim League was held at Lahore in Minto Park (Iqbal Park). Under the chairmanship of Quaid-e- Azam. The resolution was passed on 23rd March, 1940. The Resolution was moved by Bengal Chief Minister Maulvi Fazlul Haq and seconded by Chaudhry Khaliq-uz-Zaman.

Pakistan Resolution was the turning point in the history of Pakistan. It provides a way to the Muslims, leading to the destination of a complete independence.

History of Pakistan

The Pakistan Resolution is a land mark in the history of the Muslims of India. This famous Resolution results in the creation of Pakistan. The acceptance of Pakistan Resolution strengthened the Two Nation Theory which was the basis of Muslim struggle for Independence.

Pakistan Resolution was a demand for the protection and safeguard of the national identity of the Muslims. With the passage of Pakistan Resolution, the Muslims began to acquire new hope and confidence in their destiny. The Resolution infused high spirits among the Muslims who were now determined to fight to the last minute for the accomplishment of Pakistan.

History of Pakistan

- Pakistan is among only few countries that have advanced space program. All of its satellites were indigenously manufactured.
- Pakistan is among the few countries in the World that have built its own Nuclear Power Station by its own indigenous technology.
- Pakistan is among the few countries in the World that have built its own Training Aircraft (Mashaq) by its own indigenous technology.

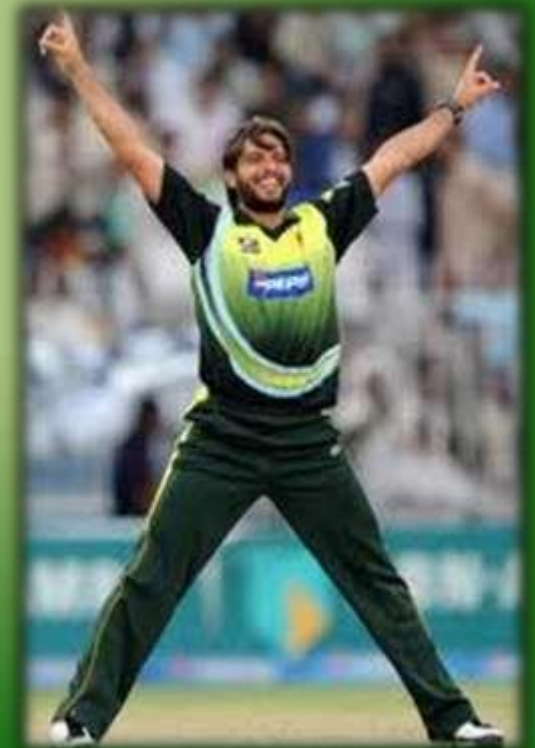

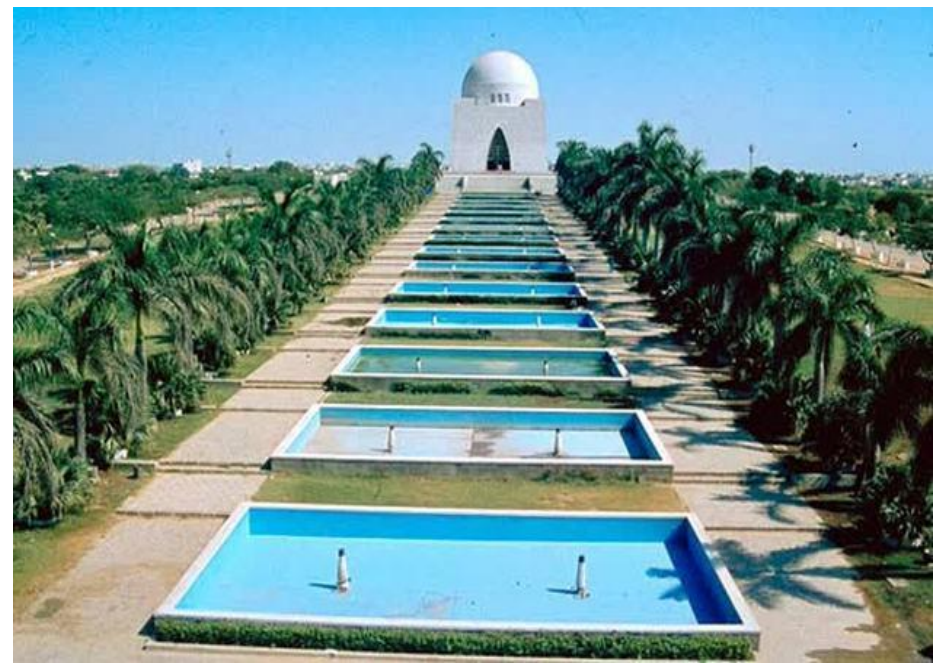

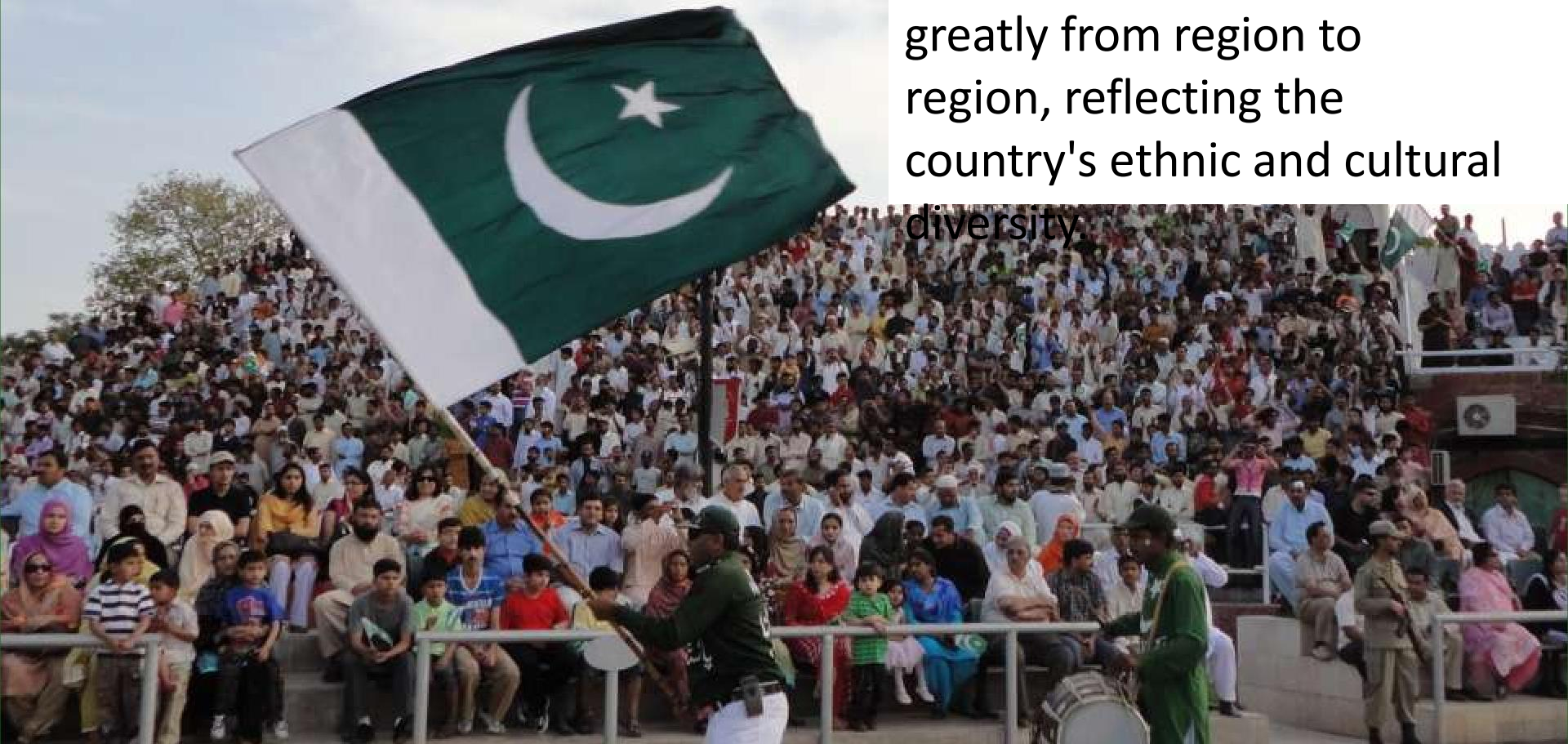

Pakistani cuisine

Refined blend of various regional cooking traditions of the South Asia . Pakistani cuisine is known for its richness and flavour. It has been partly influenced by Arab, Persian, and Indian Cuisine, it retains its own distinct Pakistani flavour.



Within Pakistan, cuisine varies greatly from region to region, reflecting the country's ethnic and cultural diversity.



Given the diversity of the people of Pakistan, cuisines generally differ from home to home and may be totally different than the mainstream Pakistani cuisine.



- As religion defines culture, so it is with the food in Pakistan as Muslims are forbidden to eat pork or consume alcohol and then halal dietary guidelines are strictly observed.
- Pakistanis focus on other areas of food such as beef, lamb, chicken, fish and vegetables as well as traditional fruit and dairy products.

Pakistani dishes are known for having spicy flavours, and some dishes often contain liberal amounts of oil which contributes to a richer flavour.

Cumin seeds, chilli powder, turmeric, Garam Masala is a very popular blend of spices used in many Pakistani dishes.

- Kebabs are a staple item in Pakistani cuisine today, and one can find countless varieties of kebabs all over the country.

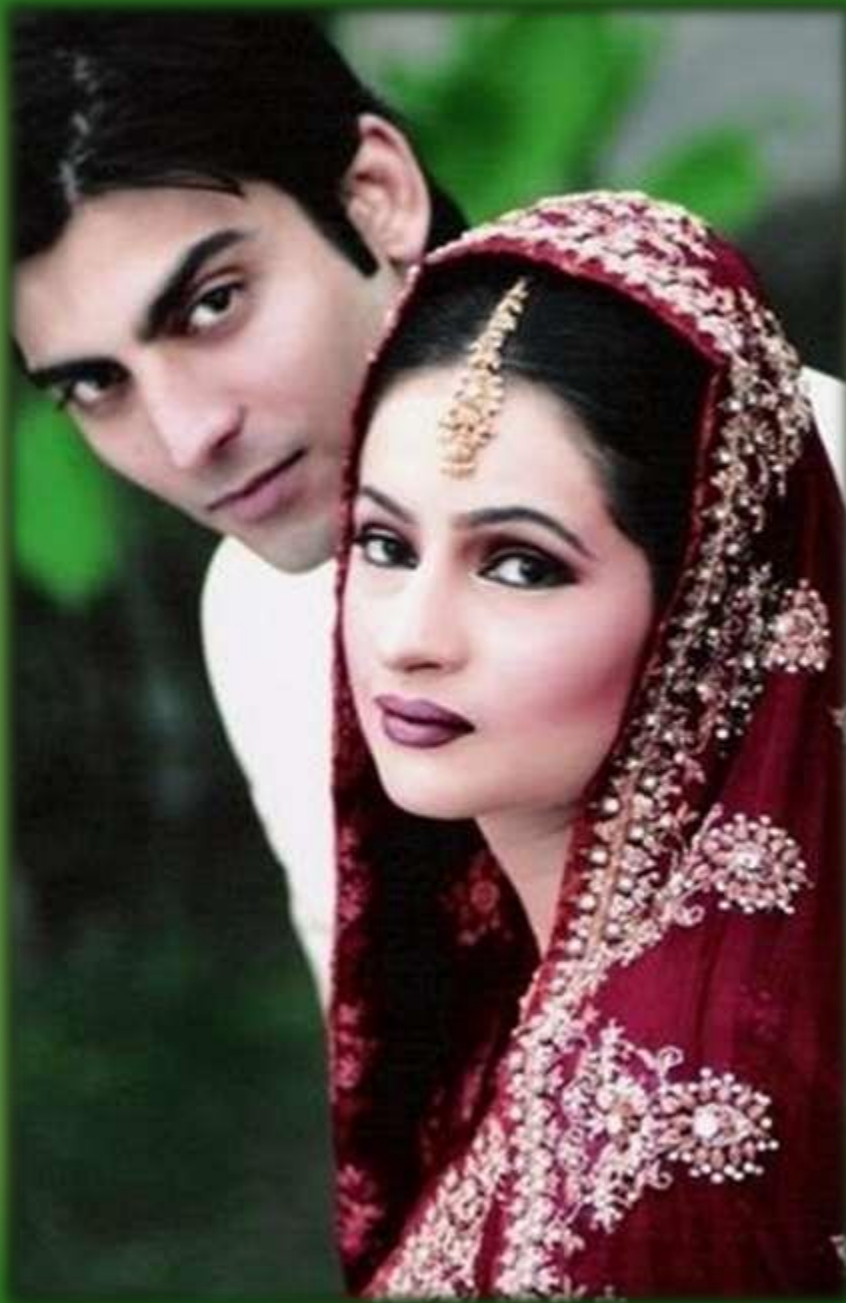


Rice dishes
