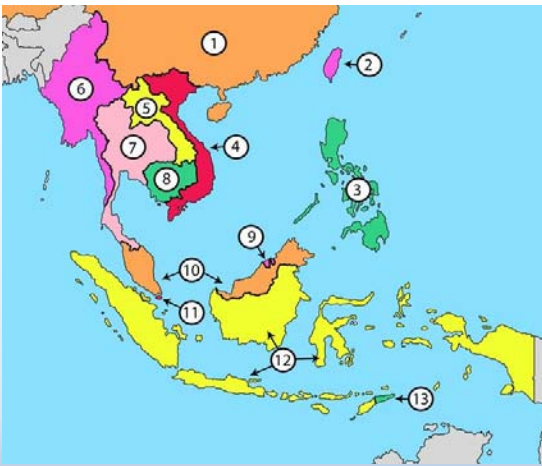

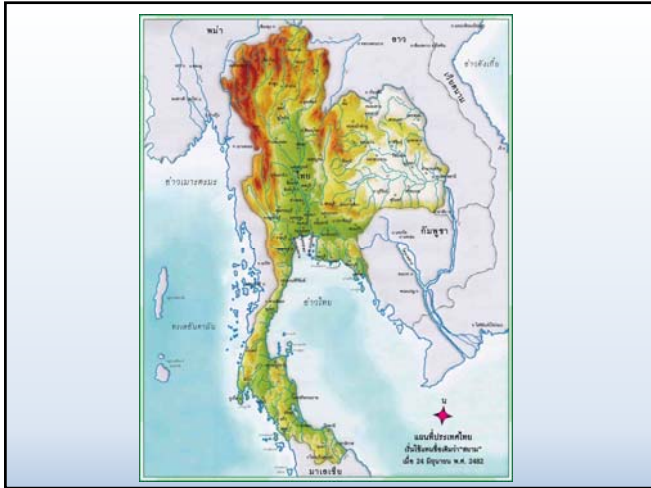

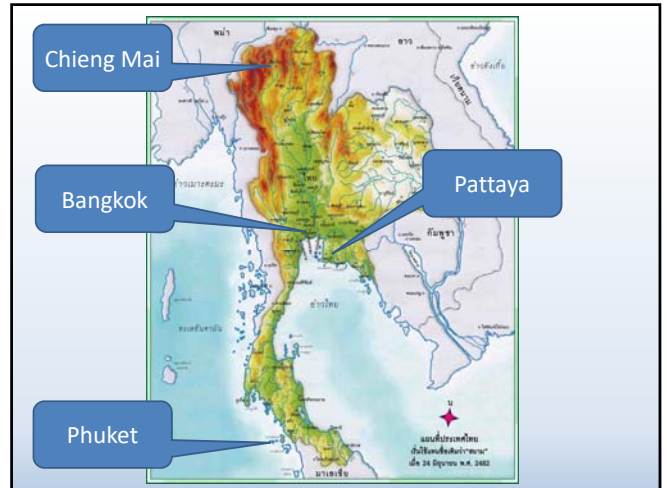


Thailand

Cultural difference between Thailand and Japan

Thai vs Japan

Thai

- Thai people call each other by their given name. We also usually place the given name before the family name.
 - Somchai (Giv) Thongdee (Fam) “Mr Somchai”
- Thai people mostly has a nickname called by friends and relatives. The nick name may not similar to the real name.
 - Somchai Thongdee “Ton”

Japanese

- Japanese people call each other by their family name
 - Yamada (Fam) Taro (Giv) “Mr Yamada”
- Japanese people also has nick name derived from their real name.
 - Yamada Hiroyuki “Hiro chan”

- Thai people eat rice in a plate with spoon and fork.

| Item | Decomposition Time |
|-----------------|--------------------|
| paper towel | 1 year |
| orange peel | 2 years |
| wool socks | 4 years |
| newspaper | 5 to 7 years |
| plastic bag | 20 years |
| nylon fabric | 40 years |
| tin can | 50 years |
| plastic cup lid | 250 years |
| aluminum can | 500 years |
| glass bottle | 1 Million years |

Garbage and the sea

- Effect of garbage to the sea
 - Garbage can destroy the sea environment. i.e. coral reefs
 - Garbage can be harmful to human
 - Garbage can be harmful to animal; they think it is eatable
 - Garbage is unpleasant for visitors
