



- 610m deep and 260km² floor area*
- Olduvai Gorge - evidence of human evolution*
- See the big five in a single day - lion, elephant, buffalo, leopard, and rhinoceros*

Mount Kilimanjaro

- Highest mountain in Africa*
- 5,895m high*
- Tallest freestanding mountain in the world*
