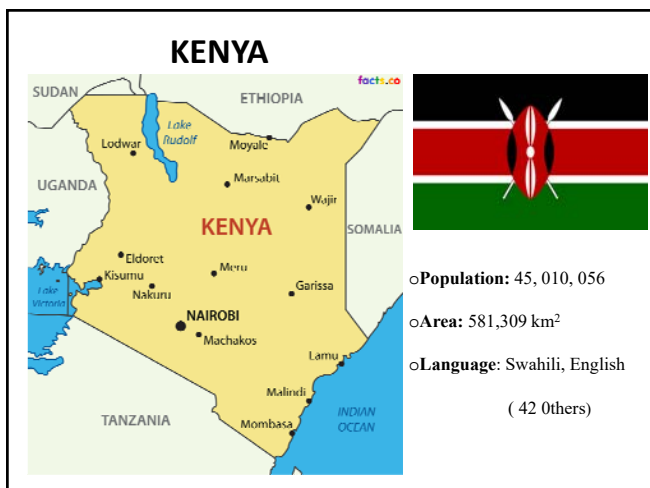

How is Kenya different from Japan

1. Greetings

In Kenya handshake is common, in Japan, people bow

2. Titles used while addressing someone

In Kenya, titles like Mr. Mrs, Miss, Dr. Prof are used, in Japan, san is commonly used

3. Gift giving.

Unlike in Japan, Kenyans have no prohibition on number of pieces and colour

4. Exchange of business cards

In Kenya, cards are exchanged informally while in Japan its done formally

5. Business meeting

In Kenya meetings rarely have scheduled ending times. Meeting only ends when all parties are finished. In Japan, meetings are timely.

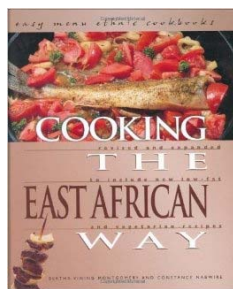

Challenges facing agriculture

1) Land degradation



- Soil erosion causing loss of fertile soils for growth of crops and pasture for animals



- Land slides that destroy crops and property bringing losses to the farmer
